

The John Milton Sixth Form 16-19 Bursary Scheme

The John Milton Sixth Form 16-19 Bursary Scheme is designed to help students in need of financial support whilst they are studying A Levels. It is to help students with the cost of travel to sixth form, text books, equipment or fieldtrips and educational visits relating to A level courses.

Allocation of funds will be dependent upon students' personal needs and those of other students. The school will make purchases on students' behalf, including travel expenses.

Eligibility

Group 1:

- Students in care or care leavers;
- Students receiving Income Support or Universal Credit because they are financially supporting themselves or has someone who is dependent and living with them such as a child or partner;
- Students receiving Disability Living Allowance or Personal Independence Payments in their own right as well as Employment and Support Allowance or Universal Credit in their own right.

Group 2:

- Students receiving free school meals (FSM) household with income below £16,190.
- Household income between £16,190 and £25,000.

There may be times through the school year where families find themselves facing hardship or exceptional circumstances but do not meet the above criteria. In these circumstance the school may be able to make discretionary payments from the Bursary scheme on an individual basis.
