At Stowupland, I will be overseeing curriculum, assessment, reporting, timetabling, our options processes, and the quality of teaching and learning. My immediate priorities will be:


- Supporting the implementation of a more rigorous approach to assessing literacy levels and intervening where we identify gaps in students' reading skills
