About the department

Maths is a core department at Stowupland High School, with a Subject Leader, Deputy Subject Leader, Lead Practitioner and four teachers.

Curriculum and resourcing

Maths teaching is in a dedicated suite of rooms in the main school, each of which has been newly refurbished. There is a well-stocked resource base and office within the department. Centralised resources have been developed by the department, including long- and mid-term plans, assessments and powerpoints for use in each lesson. The department makes use of the Sparx Maths resource.

We use the Pearson syllabus at GCSE, and for A-Level in Maths and Further Maths. We have paused the Sixth Form entry at Stowupland, and so we only have Year 13 currently (we are developing a strategy to reopen our Sixth Form in the very near future).
