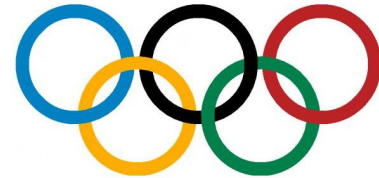
Sport & Dance News
