Behaviour

Good behaviour is vital to success both in school and beyond. As a team of staff, we have worked with the Student Council to develop a clear and explicit classroom behaviour plan which shows the rewards of good behaviour as well as the consequences that will follow if students make the wrong choices. We aim to create an environment which will always enable teachers to teach and students to learn. The classroom expectations for all students are summarised in the student planner and the school's Behaviour Policy.

Attendance

There is also a thriving Sports Council and 6th Form Committee.
