COVID-19


There are 5 vitally important principles to follow so that everyone on the school site stays safe:

COVID-19 – FEELING UNWELL

- ▶ **No student or staff member must enter the school site if they are showing any symptoms of coronavirus – they should follow Government guidance in terms of testing and isolating.**
-

COVID-19 – FEELING UNWELL

- ▶ **If a student becomes unwell at school, they will be isolated in the First Aid room until their parent or carer is able to pick them up (as soon as possible after they have been contacted).**
 - ▶ **Follow Government guidance in terms of testing and isolating**

COVID-19 – HANDWASHING

- ▶ **There are handwashing stations and sanitisers located throughout the school and grounds.**
 - ▶ **These are in addition to the handwashing facilities in the toilets.**
 - ▶ **Every student must wash their hands on arrival at school and regularly throughout the school day.**

COVID-19 – COUGHING AND SNEEZING

- ▶ **The school will promote the ‘Catch it, kill it, bin it’ approach.**
- ▶ **Students will be encouraged to use a tissue (which will be double bagged in a bin) or to cough/sneeze into their elbow in an emergency.**
- ▶ **Students are expected to follow good hand hygiene after coughing or sneezing.**

COVID-19 –CLEANING

- ▶ **All touch points and surfaces are being cleaned on an even more regular basis than before.**
- 

COVID-19 –SOCIAL DISTANCING

- ▶ **Based on the Government's guidance, we are forming year group 'bubbles'. Your child will be used to this approach from Primary School.**
- ▶ **Students in each bubble will remain in their room and the teachers will come to them.**
- ▶ **Teachers will need to socially distance from students in the classroom as much as possible.**
- ▶ **The school will be 'zoned' so that each year has its own area. Year 7 will be in the 'English' corridor.**
- ▶ **Each year will also have its own 'zone' on the field.**
- ▶ **We will not be able to use some specialist classrooms for the time being.**
- ▶ **Break and lunch times will be staggered.**



UNIFORM

- ▶ **You can find out about regulation uniform in your *'Welcome Pack'* or on the *'Transition to High School'* tab on the school website.**
- ▶ **This includes information about a 10% discount on uniform purchased from Inces (Stowmarket) before 31st August 2020.**
