

# SHS GUIDE TO REMOTE LEARNING

## FIVE STEPS TO ACCESS YOUR LEARNING FROM HOME



### 1.) HOW LEARNING IS SET

Your teachers will set learning for each subject you take. They may record lessons, set independent learning tasks or ask you to research a topic for example. Your learning will be based around what you are currently studying in school. You can check what topics are being studied on the website!

### 2.) LOG INTO SACHEL:ONE (SHOW MY HOMEWORK)

All learning will be set on Satchel:One (Show My Homework) by your teachers. Log in using your username and password to access the latest task. Remember you can leave a comment on the task for your teacher if you do not understand!



### 3.) LEARNING TASKS ON GOOGLE DRIVE

Sometimes your teachers will upload recorded lessons or videos to Google Drive. To access this you just need to click the link on your homework task and login with your school email address.

### 4.) DOWNLOAD OR VIEW YOUR TASKS ONLINE

You can download all tasks on SMHW and Google Drive to your own computer. You can also edit them and complete any tasks electronically.



### 5.) SUBMITTING WORK AND TEACHER FEEDBACK

When you have completed your remote learning tasks, simply upload them to Satchel:One (Show My Homework) to the correct teacher. They will then give you feedback in the comment section! Good luck!
