

Science Department

Stowupland Science department occupies a suite of nine Science teaching rooms, which are fitted with either a LED interactive board or data projectors, and three prep rooms. There is also a large team room, providing a workspace and a location for Science staff to meet, share thoughts and ideas. The Science team is made up of seven full-time teachers and three part-time technicians; senior leaders also teach Science across the key stages. Staff are encouraged to develop further, attending national conferences and participate in local area development groups. The team are keen to engage students in their Science education and beyond.

The department also has the use of a laptop trolley with 16 laptops.

At KS3 (Years 7 and 8), students are taught in mixed ability form groups. The curriculum is a Stowupland organised version of the NC, KS3 Programme of Study.

At KS4 (Years 9-11), students are taught in broad ability groups. We currently follow the Edexcel exam board and offer both separate science and combined science.

Generally, groups have 3 teachers; biology, chemistry and physics.
